RULES AND REGULATIONS

This is a 1 day show NO OVERNIGHT ACCOMMODATIONS WILL BE PROVIDED MUST ARRIVE MORNING OF THE SHOW. Due to limited barn space there will be no exceptions.

1. The Junior and Combined shows are separately sanctioned. These shows are sanctioned by the American Dairy Goat Association, and its rules shall govern. The sponsoring organization is the Garden State Dairy Goat Association.

2. Junior Doe and Combined shows will be held for the following breeds: Alpine, All other Purebred (includes: Sables, Guernsey and Nubians), Lamancha, Nigerian Dwarf, Oberhasi, Recorded Grade, Saanen and Toggenburg. The order of the show will be alphabetical.

3. The base date for computing animals' ages is August 12th, 2023.

4. For animals of any age, the original registration certificate or a stamped duplicate application by the ADGA office is acceptable, and will be required to be shown to the show secretary prior to the start of judging. Proof of animal's ownership is the name on registration certificate or on the stamped duplicate.

5. ALL Out of state goats entering the fair must have a CVI with in 30 days. In state goats may use a Veterinarian Certified Animal Health Certificate (AHC) with in 30days. All goats must comply with the NJSF/SCF&HS health requirements as found on sussexcountyfairgrounds.org. All animals must enter through the Vet check with their AHC/CVT's and must be stamped by the vet.

6. There will be no pre-show milk out.

7. We have a Champion Challenge class for all breeds that have finished their Championship. Champions have the option of showing in their regular age class or in the Champion Challenge class.

8. THE FOLLOWING PREMIUMS WILL BE AWARDED IN AGE AND GROUP

CLASSES:

1st place-\$16.00; 2nd place-\$12.00; 3rd place-\$10.00; 4th place-\$8.00; 5th place-\$5.00.

9. To be eligible for group classes, animals must have been shown in their individual classes.

10. To be eligible for regular entry fees, entries **must be postmarked on or before July 26, 2023**, and must be accompanied by an entry fee of \$8 per animal per ring. Any entry postmarked after July 26, 2023 will be return to exhibitor no exceptions.

PLEASE READ CAREFULLY THERE ARE SIGNIFICANT CHANGES FROM PREVIOUS YEARS.

11. Entries must be made on printed entry form only (no online entries) furnished by the New Jersey State Fair/Sussex County Farm & Horse Show. Please make sure entry form is complete, all information and signatures asked for on the entry form must be furnished. Entries will not be accepted unless this information is provided. **Make check payable to New Jersey State Fair** and send with entry blank(s) to Ag. Office; Attn: Open Dairy Goat Show, PO Box 600, Augusta, NJ 07822.

VERY IMPORTANT...Send a copy of your entry to the show chairman via e-mail at dana.eisele@icloud.com . (I don't need any of your payment information.) The show committee will be assembling the check-in, ring steward and judging sheets this year.

If you have any animals you're willing to bring to make the breed official please list those on a separate form with all information included and send with your entry to the show chairman ONLY. You will be contacted by August 1st if we need your extra animals. Don't forget to add these animals to your health papers if you're having your papers done before August 1st. If you need to scratch an animal(s) or you're unable to attend please let me know. The goal is of course to make every breed official. There will be no premiums for the animals.

12. No day of show substitutions. Substitutions may be made online to the show chairman until August 10th, 2023. Email Dana Eisele at dana.eisele@icloud.com, or text to 862-354-0128. Substitutions may be made within the show.

13. All vehicles must be moved to the outside parking lot after unloading. All animals must remain on the premises until assigned release at end of show. All vehicles must be unloaded and removed from the AG area and parked by 9:45 am. Any vehicle in the AG area after 9:45 am will be subject to be towed, and exhibitor(s) will forfeit all premiums no exceptions.

14. All animals must be checked in by 8:00am. Judging will begin at 9:00am. Judging of the Junior Doe show will commence upon completion of the judging of the Combined Doe Show. Exhibitors must have their animals in the holding area and check in with the ring steward and ready to enter the ring before judging has begun.

15. Pens are available. Please enter on the entry form the amount of pens needed. Pens are for ANIMAL USE ONLY. **Pens will be labeled with exhibitor's names.** Bring your own feed and hay; bedding is provided.

17. There will be a \$50.00 charge for checks not honored by the exhibitor's bank.

100. Dairy Herd- Four does owned by one household, limited to one group per breed per household. Herd name on the entry form.
