#### **Rules & Specifications**

This day is open to all and is not recognized by any associations or affiliations.

#### Local Day & Friends Eligibility

Open to all, no mileage restriction

#### **High Point Rider Specifications**

- Must have 3 entries in all divisions to count for day end points.
- Must have 3 entries in the same division for Champion & Reserve.
- Horse & rider combinations must be the same throughout the division.
- A rider may only show in one equitation division.
- A horse may compete in more than one hunter or equitation division with another rider. (Professionals & Open riders may compete a horse being competed by an adult or junior.)
- **High Point Rider** will be awarded to the rider with the highest overall accumulated points at the end of the day. The leadline and the 10 & under is not eligible.
- **High Point Trainer** will be awarded to the trainer with the highest overall accumulated points at the end of the day.
- Open/Professional Champion and Reserve will be awarded if 3 or more entries.

#### General Rules & Specifications

- Approved helmets are required.
- o Pre-enter <u>www.horseshowing.com</u>
- o Pre-enter by July 30, 2025
- o Entries received after the closing day are subject to a \$25 post entry fee.
- Credit cards are subject to a fee of up to 4%.
- o All entries are subject to a \$8 grounds fee.
- Class fee is \$25 per class.
- Stalls for the day will be \$35, overnight will be \$50. (early USEF move in \$40)
  - Due to the transition of the shows, stall availability is not guaranteed.
  - Stalls will be based on availability and must be reserved by the entry closing date.
  - Those moving in "early" for USEF may be subject to an additional overnight fee. We will let you know as soon as we can what we have available and will do our best to accommodate everyone this year.
- o Campers for one night will be \$40.
  - Camper space availability is not guaranteed. Spaces will be based on availability and must be reserved by the entry closing date.
- Sections are open to amateurs, juniors, adults, they are not split by junior/adult. In the event we need to split due to size we will.
- Hay & Shavings will be available based on availability.
- All fees for this event are to be paid on the day of the event and cannot be combined with any other shows.
- o Management may split or combine divisions.
- o Schooling will be permitted in designated areas.
- o Schooling breaks will be allowed between height changes as time allows.
- All horses entering the show grounds must be accompanied by a negative EIA certificate (Coggins) within one year and documentation of Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhinopneumonitis) vaccinations within 6 months and you must fill out our health declaration form. Health Certificates (within 30 days) are required for all out of state horses. These documents must be available for inspection by a representative of the State Veterinarian upon request. Horses not in compliance with this rule may be required to leave the competition grounds upon request by Competition Management.
