No Mileage Restrictions

NOTE FROM MANAGER AND SCHS HORSE SHOW COMMITTEE

We have removed the mileage restrictions to open up more opportunities for people to show. Due to the transition of the shows and being the first year we are doing this, Overnight Stalls, Camper Spaces and Supplies will be based on space availability as well as day stalls. Please email horseshowstabling@gmail.com to request stalls, camper space etc... also be sure to put Local Day in the subject. We will let you know as soon as we can what we have available and will do our best to accommodate everyone this year. We do plan to make improvements to this day in the upcoming years!

Rules & Specifications

This day is open to all and is not recognized by any associations or affiliations.

Local Day & Friends Eligibility

Open to all, no mileage restriction

Junior riders must be age 17 & under as of Dec 1 2022.

Adult riders must be 18 & over as of Dec 1 2022 and must be amateurs.

High Point Rider Specifications

*Must be 3 entries in the division to count for day end points.

*Must be 3 entries in the division for Champion & Reserve.

*Adult & Junior divisions may be combined to complete a division.

*Horse & rider combinations must be the same throughout the division.

*A rider may only show in one equitation division.

*A horse may compete in more than one hunter or equitation division with another rider.

(Professionals & Open riders may compete a horse being competed by an adult or junior.)

Walk Trot High Point Rider will be awarded to the rider with the most points accumulated in the Equitation Walk / Trot, 10 and under (classes 58-61) & The Hunter Walk / Trot, 10 and under (classes 62-65).

English Junior High Point Rider will be awarded to the junior rider with the highest overall accumulated points at the end of the day. This excludes the Junior Walk/Trot 10 & Under divisions.

English Adult High Point Rider will be awarded to the adult rider with the highest overall accumulated points at the end of the day.

Open/Professional Champion and Reserve will be awarded if 3 or more entries.

General Rules & Specifications

*Approved helmets are required.

*Pre-enter www.horseshowing.com

*Pre-enter by August 5, 2023

*Entries received after the closing day are subject to a \$25 post entry fee.

*Class fee is \$25 per class

*Stalls for the day will be \$35, overnight will be \$50. Stall availability is not guaranteed. Stalls will be based on availability and must be reserved by the entry closing date.

*Campers for one night will be \$40. Camper space availability is not guaranteed. Spaces will be based on availability and must be reserved by the entry closing date.

*Hay & Shavings will be available based on availability.

*All fees for this event are to be paid on the day of the event and can not be combined with any other shows.

*Management may combine divisions.

*Schooling will be permitted in designated areas.

*Schooling breaks will be allowed between height changes as time allows.

*Negative coggins must be presented as well as the vaccination certificate provided by Sussex County Horse Show. This can be found on the website. www.sussexcountyfairgrounds.org

Classes will be pinned at the end of day with all heights combined unless there are enough entries to split heights. Riders may ride multiple horses.
