



## **Open Breed Show Series**

### **Division:**

**Leadline** - Open to riders 7 & U. Riders are judged on suitability of mount and presentation of rider. Riders may be asked to jog. \*Handlers in this division must be 18 & over.

**11&U Walk Jog/Trot**– This division is for youth riders 11 & U. These riders may not enter any other riding division.

**Youth 18&U** – This division is open to riders 18 years of age and younger showing at a Lope/Canter. This is a Lope/Canter division. Riders in this division may cross enter into Open Walk/Jog classes, and any other classes that have a Lope/Canter.

**Limited Rider Youth/Adult** – This division is open to Youth and Adult riders of any age who have not shown at a Lope/Canter at other show. This is a Walk/Jog/Trot division, and riders may not cross enter into divisions and/or classes requiring a Lope/Canter. Once rider has either won a Year End Championship and/or 3 or more 1<sup>st</sup> place ribbons they must move from this division.

**Novice Rider** – Open to all riders (youth/adult) that have **less than 5 years** Lope/Canter experience in a show ring. If you win year end championship you will need to move up to the next division the following show season.

**Adult** - This division is open to all adult riders and is a Walk/Jog/Lope/Canter division. Riders in this division may cross enter into Open Walk/Jog/Trot classes, and any other classes that have a Lope/Canter.

**Open W/J/T** – Open to all riders. This is combined for youth and adult riders.

**Halter** – These classes will award placings 1<sup>st</sup> thru 6<sup>th</sup> place. Handlers of stallions must be over 18 years old.

## **General Rules** **Open Breed & Ranch**

Coggins and vaccinations must be current and available at all times.

All horses entering the show grounds must be accompanied by a negative EIA certificate (Coggins) within one year and documentation of Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhinopneumonitis) vaccinations within 6 months and you must fill out our health declaration form. Health Certificates (within 30 days) are required for all out of state horses. These documents must be available for inspection by a representative of the State Veterinarian upon request. Horses not in compliance with this rule may be required to leave the competition grounds upon request by Competition Management.

Back Numbers – Back Numbers will be assigned as a rider/horse combination\*\*

Non-Showing Horse - All Horses on premises that are not showing must be assigned a back number and will be charged \$40.00 plus the office & grounds fee. If a stall is used the stall will be also charged.

Management reserves the right to cancel/combine, move or substitute classes at their discretion.

Day End Awards – you must show in at least 3 classes for that division

Year End Awards - you must show in at least 3 classes for that division & you must be a member before you enter the ring for your first class of the day in order to accumulate points. (if you join after the show your points will not count)

Birthdates must be provided with membership for awards.

Pre-entries are preferred on [www.sussex.horsespot.net](http://www.sussex.horsespot.net) , email entries will be accepted.

- For the 2026 Show Season entries are due Thursday - 4/23 9PM & Thursday - 5/14 9PM
- Any entries received after that will be charged \$20
- Entry submission instructions on schedule.
- When emailing please send a PDF *not JPG or PNG*.

A check or credit card must be given when you check in and will be used in the event you do not check out. Failure to checkout is subject to a \$10 additional charge.

Any class-related questions must be taken to the show manager or ring steward. No one is to approach the judge without management's permission.

Credit cards are accepted, and a percentage will be charged automatically by the merchant account provider. Currently the amount is 4% and is subject to change.

SCHS Show Management approved refunds will be processed within 15 days of the event. The refund will be issued via check and mailed to the address on file.

Outstanding balance will be added to the next show bill. If you do not show you will be contacted to make payment.
