#### **General Information & Rules and Regulations:**

- Please pre-enter.
- Pre-enter using <u>www.horseshowing.com</u>
- Post entries which are accepted will be subject to a \$25 post entry fee.
- Permanent Stalls available Overnight and Day of show. Overnight: \$40 Day Of: \$30, You must bring your own hay and shavings
- Stalls are 10 X 10, wooden stalls with sliding doors. Flooring varies; some have installed rubber mats, some pavers and some QP aggregate
- There will be a \$30 charge for horses/ponies schooled but not shown
- All horses/ponies just schooling are required to wear an assigned back number from the office.
- Credit cards are subject to a 3% processing fee.
- Approved headgear is required, per USEF GR801.
- Sussex County Horse Show, staff, committee members, and volunteers will not be responsible for any accident, loss or damage during a show.
- SCHS Committee reserves the right to cancel/combine, move or substitute classes at their discretion
- Schooling will be permitted only in designated areas
- Schooling will be scheduled during the show as time permits
- Rings are approximately 400x300 and 300x200; stone dust, groomed and watered footing
- All warm up areas are sand and fiber footing or stone dust
- Hunters will be judged on performance, soundness, and manners
- Every class offered is run in accordance with the specs of the current USEF rules.
- A jump order will be established at the gate with the starter
- All ties, other than first, will remain tied
- All pets must be kept on a leash
- Sharps containers will be located at the show office
- All entries not paid at the horse show will incur a \$50.00 late payment fee
- A \$35 Office fee will be charged to all entries which includes EMT.
- SCHS Show Management approved refunds will be processed within 15 days of the event. The refund will be issued via check and mailed to the address on file.
- For all sanctioned classes other than USEF pointed classes (such as NAL/THIS/Ariat/M&S Classics, Stakes, Derby Classes) horse and rider combination must enter at least one other class at the same show
- Prize money will be credited towards show bill. Any monies still owed will be issued in the form of a check.
- Horse (hunter/jumper) or rider (equitation) must compete in 3 of the 6 English Benefit Series shows to be eligible for Series End Awards. 3 horses/riders must compete in a class in order to receive full SCHS points. Classes less than 3 will be awarded half points. Please see year end specifications.
- SCHS offers exhibitors measurements. However, All measurements must be made by appointment. Measurements take place between 8:00 and 9:00am the day of the show. Any measurements taken after that will be done at the exhibitor's expense.
- Should a communicable outbreak occur during the current Horse Show season impacting our region/area, Sussex County Horse Show/NJ Fairgrounds reserves the right to require additional proof of vaccines as noted on the sussexcountyhorseshow.org website. Please refer to the full policy available on the website

#### **Take2 Eligibility Specs**

- TAKE2 is open to all Thoroughbreds\* verified by The Jockey Club registrations papers or lip tattoo number at time of entry. Raced and unraced Thoroughbreds are eligible for the program. There will be no co-branding or co-sponsorship allowed with any TAKE2 sponsored division or class.
- The TAKE2 Thoroughbred Hunter Division
  - Includes two-to-four classes over fences and an under-saddle class. Fences at 3'0".
- The TAKE2 Low Child/Adult Jumper Division
  - Includes one or two classes, fences at 3'3"/1.0 meter.

#### USEF Membership Statement


Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, or agent, at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot (exception: Friesian performance FR231) and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes

#### Motorized Vehicle Statement

Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.







#### English Benefit Show Year-End Award Requirements 2023!

**To be eligible for SCHS Benefit Series Year End awards you must meet the criteria listed below for horse & rider.** (*The August Fair Show & Local Day is not included.*)

#### Horse (Hunter/Jumper)

The horse must compete in the same division and the same section/height at 3 shows to be eligible for a year end award.

**Rider (Equitation)** The rider must compete in the same division and the same section/height at 3 shows to be eligible for a year end award.

Points are awarded First to Sixth Place in each class for classes that have 3 or more entries. First 10, Second 6, Third 4, Fourth 2, Fifth 1, Sixth, .5

If a class has less than 3 entries half points will be awarded.

First 5, Second 3

The June 24<sup>th</sup> show will be Double Pointed for SCHS Benefit Series Year End awards ONLY!

Year-end awards will be awarded to those who meet the criteria above

Grand & Reserve Will receive a ribbon & prize 3rd-8<sup>th</sup> Place Will receive ribbons



and any legal and personal representatives, executors, administrators, successors, and assigns, hereby agree to and make the following contractual repre-sentations pursuant to this Agreement (the "Agreement"):

A. RULES AND REGULATIONS: I hereby agree that I have read, understand, and agree to be bound by all applicable Federation Bylaws, rules, and policies including the USEF Safe Sport Policy and Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies (MAAPP) as published at www.usef.org, as amended from time to time.

B. 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
