- Open to riders of all ages and disciplines.
- Miniature horses, ponies and horses' are welcome

Costume Freestyle Trail Specifications:

- \$200 Freestyle Costume Class is for riders of all levels and disciplines.
- Payout requires a minimum of three exhibitors in class. Winner takes all.
- Design your own course on the template provided and have one available for the judge. Execute a maximum of eight obstacles and a minimum of five obstacles
- Utilize walk, trot or jog, canter or lope to your abilities.
- Music may be utilized.
- In order to participate in the freestyle class you must compete in one other trail class.

Judging Specifications:

- 50% judged on creativity, costume, performance/showmanship, originality
- 50% Judged on execution of pattern and elements provided on your pattern sheet

Safety Specifications::

- Do not dismount if on horseback.
- Consider safety in relation to costumes.
- Maintain control and safety at all times.
- Bareback is not allowed
- Bridles are required
- All tack must stay on horse at all times. Including but not limited to saddle, bridle and girth.
