**Health Regulations**

**New Jersey Law requires Pullorum-typhoid testing within 90 days of exhibit in order to show or sell birds. BE PREPARED TO HAVE YOUR BIRDS CHECKED FOR PULLORUM CERTIFICATES. (WATERFOWL ARE EXEMPT)**  
**All county fairs are under the auspices of New Jersey Department of Agriculture. State inspectors will be present on the fairgrounds.**

- All birds must have an official Pullorum VS Form 9-2 or 9-3
- All birds must test negative to Pullorum-typhoid within 90 days prior to the exhibit
- All birds under 4 months of age shall originate from Pullorum-typhoid negative flocks. (The individual test is not valid for birds in this age group)
- Turkeys shall be blood tested at more than 12 weeks of age
- Game birds shall be tested when more than 4 months of age or upon reaching sexual maturity, whichever comes first
- All poultry and hatching eggs, including chickens, turkeys, guinea fowl, peafowl, quail, grouse, chukars, pheasants, ratites (ostrich, emu, rhea, and cassowaries), , pigeons, and doves shall be accompanied by an official CVI or VS Form 9-2 or 9-3.
- All poultry (with the exception of pigeons and doves) and hatching eggs:
  - Shall originate from U.S. Pullorum-Typhoid Clean or equivalent flocks; or
  - Shall have an individual negative Pullorum-Typhoid test performed within 90 days prior to the exhibit by meeting the testing requirements below:
    - Poultry (with the exception of those types listed below) shall be tested when more than four (4) months of age. Poultry under 4 months shall originate from Pullorum-Typhoid negative flocks.
    - Turkeys shall be blood tested when more than 12 weeks of age. Turkeys under 12 weeks of age shall originate from Pullorum-Typhoid negative flocks. Turkeys shall only be tested by NJDA authorized personnel.
    - Game birds (includes quail, chukar, grouse, and pheasant) shall be tested when more than 4 months of age or upon reaching sexual maturity, whichever comes first. Game birds under 4 months shall originate from Pullorum-Typhoid negative flocks.
    - Ostrich, emu, rhea, and cassowaries shall be blood tested when more than 12 months of age. All ostrich, emus, rhea, and cassowaries less than 12 months shall originate from Pullorum-Typhoid negative flocks.
    - Pigeons, and doves are exempt from Pullorum-Typhoid testing.

**All Out of State Poultry**

- All birds must have an official Pullorum VS Form 9-2 or 9-3
- All birds must test negative to Pullorum-typhoid within 90 days prior to the exhibit
- All birds under 4 months of age shall originate from Pullorum-typhoid negative flocks. (The individual test is not valid for birds in this age group)
- Turkeys shall be blood tested at more than 12 weeks of age
- Game birds shall be tested when more than 4 months of age or upon reaching sexual maturity, whichever comes first
- All poultry and hatching eggs, including chickens, turkeys, guinea fowl, peafowl, quail, grouse, chukars, pheasants, ratites (ostrich, emu, rhea, and cassowaries), , pigeons, and doves shall be accompanied by an official CVI or VS Form 9-2 or 9-3.
  - All poultry and hatching eggs, including chickens, turkeys, guinea fowl, peafowl, quail, grouse, chukars, pheasants, ratites (ostrich, emu, rhea, and cassowaries), , with the exception of pigeons and doves:
    - o Shall originate and move directly from an established flock that participates in the NPIP

U.S. Avian Influenza Clean program or NPIP U.S. H5/H7 Avian Influenza Clean or Monitored program; or

- o Shall originate and move directly from a test negative Avian Influenza monitored flock (as defined in N.J.A.C. 2:9-2.1); or
- o Poultry less than 7 days of age is exempt from testing requirements if these birds originate and move directly from a breeding flock that meets the requirements above.
- o Pigeons and doves are exempt from Avian Influenza testing.

Please note: Concerns regarding the Avian Influenza virus (also known as “bird flu”) continue.

All poultry owners need to be on the lookout for signs of illness in their poultry and use good biosecurity practices to protect birds. Signs of HPAI may include a sudden increase in bird deaths, sneezing, gasping for air, coughing and nasal discharge (runny nose), watery and/or green diarrhea, lack of energy and poor appetite, drop in egg production, or soft- or thin-shelled misshapen eggs, swelling around the eyes, neck, and head and purple discoloration of the wattles, combs, and legs. To protect the State’s poultry industry, the NJDA recommends that the fair or show management adopt rules requiring all exhibited poultry and hatching eggs to be accompanied by a certification that they are free from avian influenza, regardless of where the birds originated. Fair and show management should remain vigilant for sick birds:

Only allow healthy birds to attend the show. Designate separate areas to show and gallinaceous poultry. Do not allow the sharing of any equipment. Do not allow touching/petting of birds. Clean and disinfect frequently. Remove sick birds and report immediately. Use a deterrent to keep wild birds away. If HPAI is detected in NJ, the NJDA may ask for the cancellation of fairs and shows on short notice to prevent the spread of the HPAI.

#### **Special notice for all poultry exhibitors**

If any emergency conditions, including outbreaks of certain infectious diseases, warrant additional restrictions on any species of animals moving into and/or through the state, additional emergency rules may be enacted and all fair and show managers will be notified.

4. **ALL ENTRIES MUST BE POSTMARKED ON OR BEFORE JULY 21st TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR \$2 PER BIRD FEE. THOSE POSTMARKED JULY 22-26th MUST PAY A \$4 PER BIRD FEE. NO ENTRIES POST-MARKED AFTER JULY 26th WILL BE ACCEPTED.** No in person entries accepted after Monday, July 29th.
5. The show hall will be open Friday, August 2, 2024 from 2:00pm – 8:00pm. All entries must be cooped by Saturday, August 3rd by 12:00pm
6. **LIMITED TO THE FIRST 100 BIRD ENTRIES AND/OR POSTMARK. ALL ENTRY FEES MUST ACCOMPANY APPLICATION, OR THEY WILL BE RETURNED. PLEASE FILL OUT ENTRY FORM COMPLETELY AND NEATLY.**
7. ALL BIRDS MUST REMAIN ON DISPLAY UNTIL SATURDAY, AUGUST 10TH AT 5:00 pm UNLESS RELEASED BY THE FARM & HORSE SHOW COMMITTEE. (Certain circumstances may apply).
8. **All awards/premiums must be picked up by 6pm Saturday, August 10th**
9. Judging will take place on Saturday, August 3rd at 1:00 pm.
10. **Premiums:** 1st place-\$5.00; 2nd place-\$4.00; 3rd place-\$3.00; Grand Champion Poultry-\$25.00; Reserve Champion Poultry-\$20.00; Champion Large/Bantam/Standard Duck/Bantam Duck/Goose/Turkey/and Pigeon-\$15.00; Reserve Champion Large/Bantam/Standard Duck/Bantam Duck/Goose/Turkey/and Pigeon -\$10.00; Artie Passafaro Memorial Trophy Champion Bird - \$10.00
11. We are asking that anyone wishing to show; help keep the barn clean by sweeping and picking up and by helping to water birds, on a daily basis. See Show Secretary for schedules.
12. Any bird showing signs of contagious disease & or parasites, will be removed from the show hall, and must be picked up!
13. **Exhibitors are responsible for feeding and watering their birds daily during the Fair.** Food and water will be available at the show hall. IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE OWNER TO SUPPLY APPROVED TYPE CONTAINERS, 2 PER CAGE, ONE FOR WATER AND ONE FOR FEED; EACH CAGE MUST HAVE 2 PROPER CONTAINERS. **Containers must be Kuhl Corporation Cup-K or equivalent as approved by the Poultry Show Director. Approved feed and water containers will be available for purchase in the Poultry Exhibit Barn.**

**Birds must be checked on a daily basis AND cages must be cleaned daily.** All feed/water containers must be secured to cage sides or front corners to prevent tipping over. Even for small bantams, hook-on feeders should be on at least the second bar from the bottom to prevent soiling. We are pleased to "freshen" feed and water in the morning, since most exhibitors cannot be present at that time. HOWEVER, each bird exhibited must be checked, either by the exhibitor or his/her representative daily and cleaning and feeding done as necessary. Supplies are available in the show hall. If birds have not been cared for, for more than 3 days, they will be asked to leave.

### **Waterfowl MUST be cleaned on a daily basis.**

### RULES & REGULATIONS

#### ONLY CHICKEN AND DUCK EGGS WILL BE ACCEPTED

- Eggs are judged on the following:
  - Uniformity of Color
  - Uniformity of Size
  - Presentation(cleanliness of eggs and box, consistency of presentation of eggs in carton)
- Eggs are all Brown, all White or all Colored
- Eggs are all the same size and color, in carton, **HALF DOZEN PLEASE**
- Entry fee is \$1.00 per **half-dozen**
- Eggs are to be brought in on the first Saturday from 11:00am to 3:00pm, or Sunday before 11:00 AM, to be judged on the first Sunday**
- No passes** will be given out for egg only entries
- No Geese eggs will be accepted
- Judge will pick the best 3 half-dozen in each class**
- Premiums: 1st - \$16.00; 2nd - \$8.00; 3rd - \$5.00;  
Champion Chicken Egg - \$10.00; Reserve Champion Chicken Egg - \$5.00    Champion Duck Egg - \$10.00; Reserve Champion Duck Egg - \$5.00
- Class must consist of 3 or more entries to receive an award.**

**NATIONAL CODE OF SHOW RING ETHICS**

Exhibitors of animals at livestock shows shall at all times conduct themselves with honesty and good sportsmanship. Their conduct in this competitive environment shall always reflect the highest standards of honor and dignity to promote the advancement of agricultural education. This code applies to junior, as well as open class exhibitors, who compete in structured classes of competition. This code applies to all livestock offered in any event at a livestock show. In addition to the "IAFE National Code of Show Ring Ethics," fairs and livestock shows may have rules and regulations which they impose on the local, county, state, provincial, and national levels.

All youth leaders working with junior exhibitors are under an affirmative responsibility to do more than avoid improper conduct or questionable acts. Their moral values must be so certain and positive that those younger and more pliable will be influenced by their fine example. Owners, exhibitors, fitters, trainers, and absolutely responsible persons who violate the code of ethics will forfeit premiums, awards, and auction proceeds and shall be prohibited from future exhibition in accordance with the rules adopted by the respective fairs and livestock shows. Exhibitors who violate this code of ethics demean the integrity of all livestock exhibitors and should be prohibited from competition at all livestock shows in the United States and Canada.

**The following is a list of guidelines for all exhibitors and all livestock in competitive events:**

1. All exhibitors must present, upon request of fair and livestock show officials, proof of ownership, length of ownership, and age of all animals entered. Misrepresentation of ownership, age, or any facts relating thereto is prohibited.
2. Owners, exhibitors, fitters, trainers, or absolutely responsible persons shall provide animals health certificates from licensed veterinarians upon request by fair or livestock show officials.
3. Junior exhibitors are expected to care for and groom their animals while at fairs or livestock shows.
4. Animals shall be presented to show events where they will enter the food chain free of violative drug residues. This act of entering an animal in a livestock show is the giving of consent by the owner, exhibitor, fitter, trainers and/or absolutely responsible person for show management to obtain any specimens of urine, saliva, blood, or other substances from the animal to be used in testing. Animals not entered in an event which culminates with the animal entering the food chain shall not be administered drugs from other than in accordance with applicable federal, state, and provincial statutes, regulations and rules. Livestock shall not be exhibited if the drugs administered in accordance with federal, state and provincial statutes, regulations and rules affect the animal's performance or appearance at the event. If the laboratory report on the analysis of saliva, urine, blood, or other sample taken from livestock indicates the presence of forbidden drugs or medication, this shall be prima facie evidence such substance has been administered to the animal either internally or externally. It is presumed that the sample of urine, saliva, blood, or other substance tested by the approved laboratory to which it is sent is the one taken from the animal in question, its integrity is preserved, all procedures of said collection and preservation transfer to the laboratory and analysis of the sample are correct and accurate. The report received from the laboratory pertains to the sample taken from the animal in question and correctly reflects the condition of the animal at the time the sample was taken, with the burden on the owner, exhibitor, fitter, trainer, or absolutely responsible person to prove otherwise. At any time after an animal arrives on the fair or livestock show premises, all treatments involving the use of drugs and/or medications for the sole purpose of protecting the health of the animal shall be administered by a licensed veterinarian.
5. Any surgical procedure or injection of any foreign substance or drug or external application of any substance (irritant, counterirritant or similar substance) which could affect the animal's performance or alter its natural contour, confirmation, or appearance, except external applications of substances to the hoofs or horns of animals which affect appearance only, and except for surgical procedures performed by a duly licensed veterinarian for the sole purpose of protecting the health of the animal, is prohibited.
6. The use of showing and/or handling practices or devices, such as striking animals to cause swelling using electrical contrivance, or other similar practices are not acceptable and are prohibited.
7. Direct criticism or interference with the judge, fair or livestock show management, other exhibitors, breed representatives, or show official before, during, or after the competitive event is prohibited. In the furtherance of their official duty, all judges, fair and livestock show management, or other show officials shall be treated with courtesy, cooperation, and respect. No person shall direct abusive or threatening conduct toward them.

8. No owner, exhibitor, fitter, trainer, or absolutely responsible person shall conspire with another person or persons to intentionally violate this code of ethics or knowingly contribute or cooperate with another person or persons either by affirmative action or inaction to violate this code of ethics. Violation of this rule shall subject such individual to disciplinary action.
9. The application of this code of ethics provides for absolute responsibility for an animal's condition by an owner, exhibitor, fitter, or participant whether or not he or she was actually instrumental in or had actual knowledge of the treatment of the animal in contravention of this code of ethics.
10. The act of entering an animal is the giving of consent by the owner, exhibitor, fitter, trainer, or absolutely responsible person to have any disciplinary action taken by the fair or livestock show for violation of this Code of Show Ring Ethics and any other rules of competition of the fair or livestock show without recourse against the fair or livestock show. The act of entering an animal is the giving of consent that any proceedings or disciplinary action taken by the fair or livestock show may be published with the name of the violator or violators in any publication of the International Association of Fairs and Expositions, including *Fairs and Expos* and any special notices to members.
11. The act of entering an animal in a fair or livestock show is the giving of verification by the owner, fitter, trainer, or absolutely responsible person that he or she has read the IAFE National Code of Show Ring Ethics and understands the consequences of and penalties provided for actions prohibited by this code. It is further a consent that an action which contravenes these rules and is also in violation of federal, state, or provincial statutes, regulations, or rules may be released to appropriate law enforcement authorities with jurisdiction over such infractions.
